

# Petition to Implement a White Horse Beach/Manomet Heights Resident Permit Parking Program

Petition summary and background	<p>Curbside Parking in the White Horse Beach/Manomet Heights neighborhood is extremely limited, specifically during the summer months. Over the past several years, White Horse Beach has seen an increase in non-resident visitors during the summer months, which forces tax-paying residents, property owners, and handicap residents to park far away from their homes. People are parking wherever they can fit their vehicles, illegally parking, blocking mailboxes and driveways, and leaving trash along Taylor Ave and all side roads, as well as the beach, regardless of barrels.</p> <p>There are 167 ocean-side Taylor Ave properties within Town Assessor’s Map 45C. Only 32 properties have off-street parking, and the Taylor Ave Lot, which is town-owned, and requires a beach sticker, has 20 spots. Many residents rely on the limited curbside parking, and/or privately-owned vacant lots for parking, which is still inadequate during the summer months. During the summer months, property owners are unable to park near our homes due to visitors taking all the available parking spots on Taylor Ave and surrounding side streets.</p> <p>We need to take our traffic and parking policies seriously when it comes to balancing the legitimate interests of visitor parking against the equally legitimate concerns of residents and our expectation to curbside parking outside our homes. Tax-paying property owners and residents should have priority for the limited curbside parking before non-residents. A neighborhood resident parking solution is necessary.</p>
Action petitioned for	<p>We, the undersigned residents and property owners, are concerned citizens who urge our leaders to act now to implement a Resident Permit Parking Program for legitimate curbside parking areas in White Horse Beach/Manomet Heights, as found on Town Assessor’s map 45A, 45B, 45C and Taylor Ave area on Map 46 (attached). Residents in favor are requesting a Residential Permit Parking Program that restricts parking along Taylor Ave and side streets to residents and their visitors only, by annual permit, with enforcement from April 1 – October 1 annually.</p>
